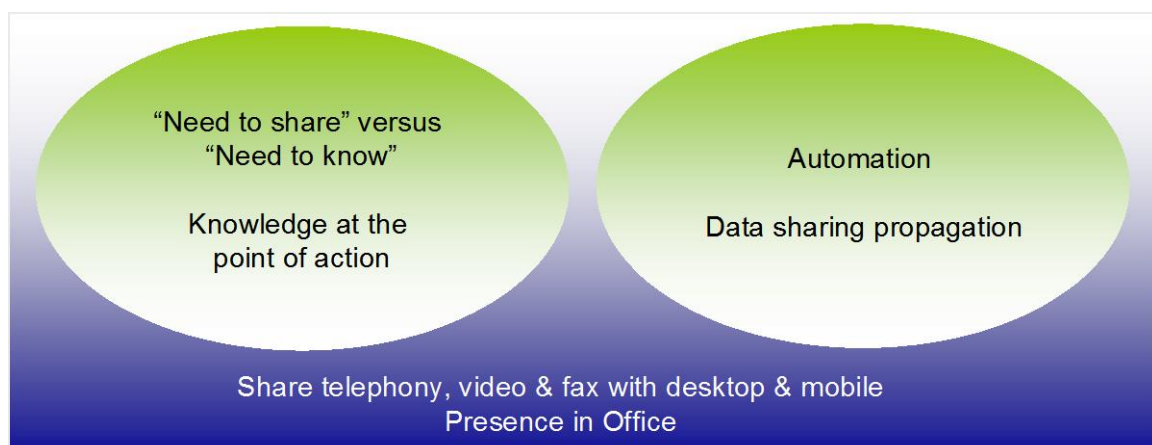

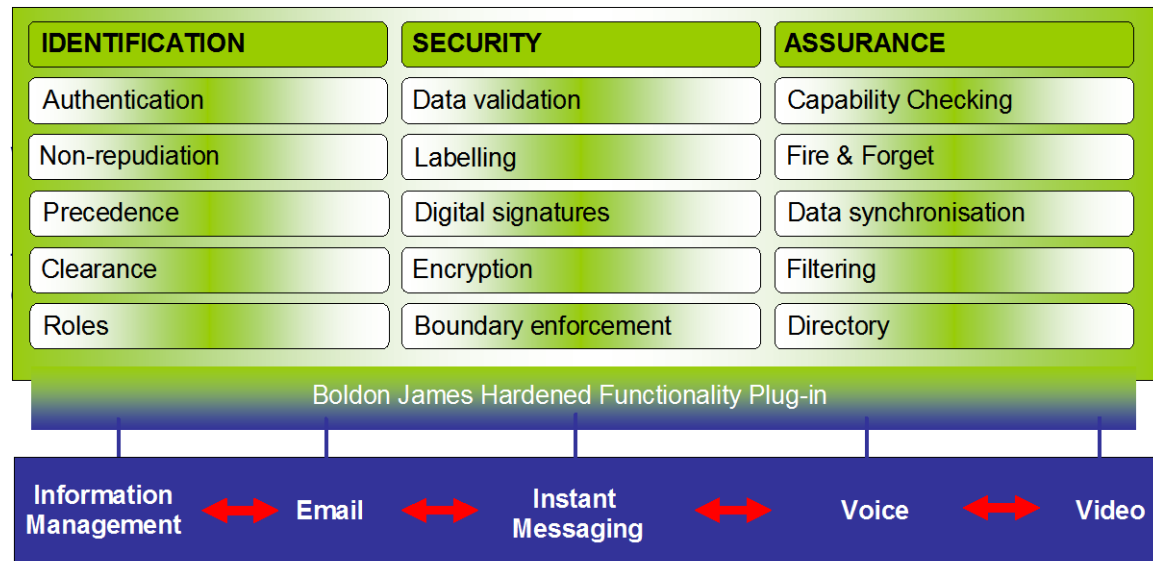
- The “Need to share” versus the “Need to know”
